"The Church: Body"

Communion Liturgy

Pastor: ^{Isa 9:6} For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Congregation!: ^{1Co 11:23} For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, ²⁴ and when he had given thanks, he broke it ...

Pastor: ^{Isa 52:8} Listen! Your watchmen lift up their voices; together they shout for joy. When the LORD returns to Zion, they will see it with their own eyes.

^{Isa 52:9} Burst into songs of joy together, you ruins of Jerusalem, for the LORD has comforted his people, he has redeemed Jerusalem.

^{Isa 52:10} The LORD will lay bare his holy arm in the sight of all the nations, and all the ends of the earth will see the salvation of our God.

Congregation: ^{1Co 11:23} and (Jesus) said, “This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.”

Pastor: ^{Isa 53:1} Who has believed our message and to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

^{Isa 53:2} He grew up before him like a tender shoot, and like a root out of dry ground. He had no beauty or majesty to attract us to him, nothing in his appearance that we should desire him.

^{Isa 53:3} He was despised and rejected by others, a man of suffering, and familiar with pain. Like one from whom people hide their faces he was despised, and we held him in low esteem.

Congregation: ^{1Co 11:25} In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.” ²⁶ For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.

Pastor: ^{Isa 53:4} Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. ^{Isa 53:5} But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.

Congregation: ^{1Co 11:27} So then, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. ²⁸ Everyone ought to examine themselves before they eat of the bread and drink of the cup.

Pastor: ^{Isa 53:6} We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Congregation: ²⁹ For those who eat and drink without discerning the body of Christ eat and drink judgment on themselves.

Pastor: ^{Isa 1:18} “Come now, let us reason together,” says the LORD. “Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool.
