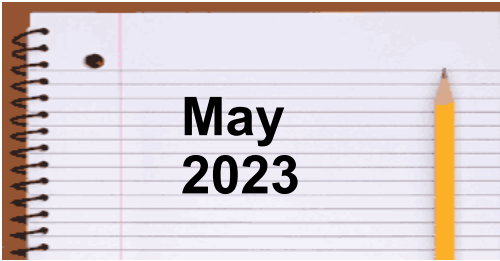

1. Chairman Verlan Van Wyk opened the meeting with devotions and prayer. The needs of many in the church and community were lifted in prayer.
2. The elders were honored to hear the testimonies of many in our church through their professions of faith. It was a joyful experience and we rejoice with each individual and their families!
3. Financial information and reports were reviewed. The general fund balance is at about \$155,000.
4. Gary Christensen and Mike Vander Molen are our council delegates to the May Classis Central Plains meeting that will be held either May 17 or 18 meeting at Faith CRC in Pella. Landon Van Zante and Trevor Nikkel are alternates.
5. Family visitation will take place in August this year. More details will be provided in the coming months.
6. Council approved a request from Justin Van Zee to release him from his ordination in order to follow a shift in his calling. This will come as a motion from Sully CRC to Classis Central Plains at the fall classis meeting. We are thankful for Justin's heart for serving where God leads him!
7. Council approved the Church Expansion Committee's request to engage SVPA Architects to work with the committee in refining the concepts that are being considered, develop preliminary plans and provide some initial estimates.
8. Pastor Brad Bierma of Calvary CRC in Pella led a training for all shepherding elders and deacons on April 24.
9. The council held a senior night for many of the seniors from our church and 412 youth group, along with their families, on April 19. It was a wonderful night of fellowship and encouragement.

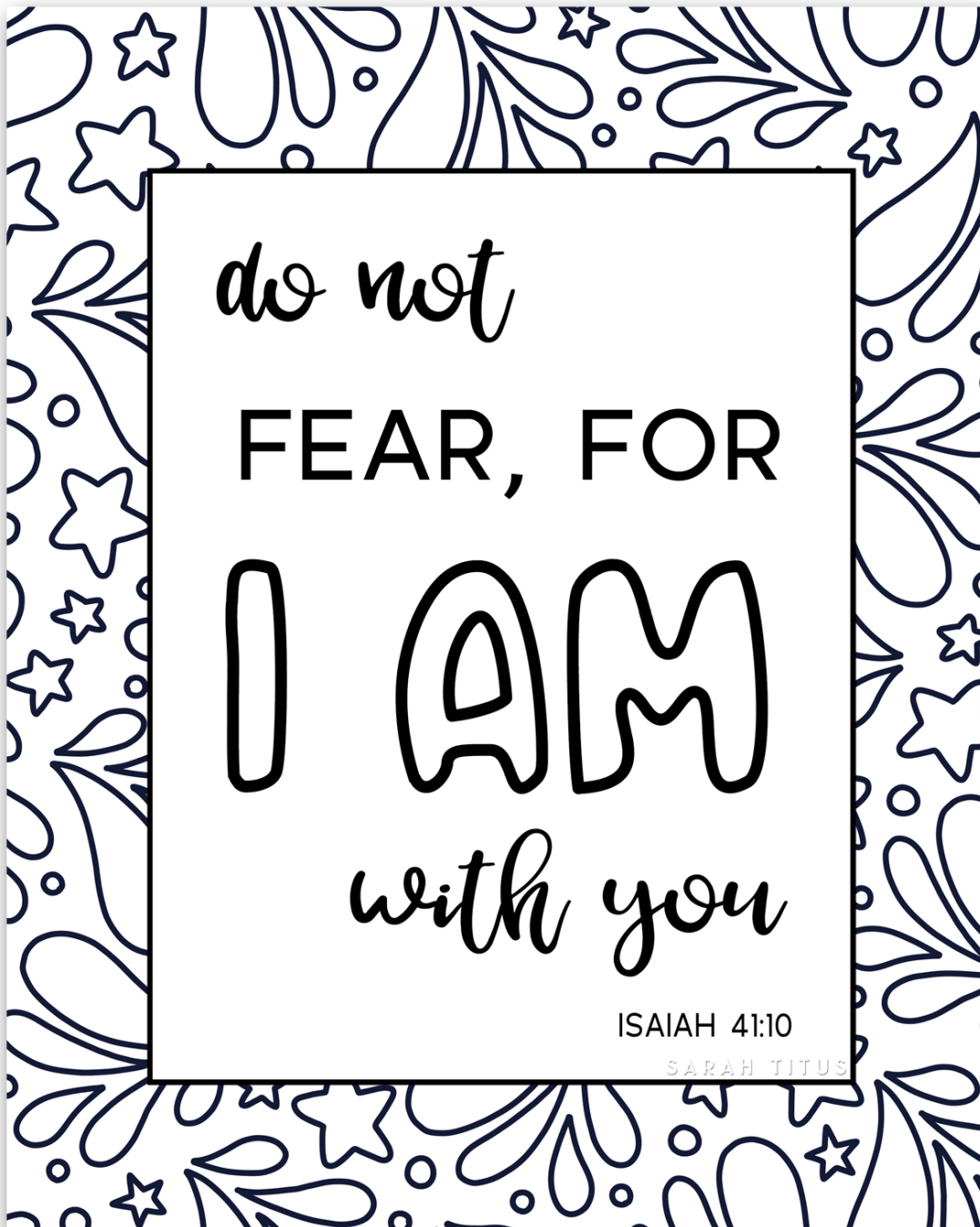
