God's will for our lives of Thanksgiving & Joy

The 10 commandments with a response from the Heidelberg catechism

Leader: God said, "You shall have no other gods before me".

Congregation: I will acknowledge the one true God, look to Him for every good thing, love Him, trust Him, and honor Him with all my heart.

L: "You shall not make for yourself an idol"

C: I will worship God in spirit and in truth, for this is the kind of worship that pleases Him.

L: "You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God".

C: I will use the holy name of God with reverence and awe, and praise Him in everything I think, say, and do.

L: "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy".

C: I will regularly attend the assembly of God's people, rest from my evil ways every day of my life, let the Lord work in me through the Holy Spirit, and so begin already in this life the eternal Sabbath.

L: "Honor your father and your mother".

C: I will honor, love, obey, and be loyal to my parents, be patient with their failings, and give due respect to all those who are in authority over me.

L: "You shall not murder".

C: I will not belittle, insult, hate, or kill my neighbor, not by my thoughts, my words, my looks or gestures or actions.

L: "You shall not commit adultery".

C: As a temple of the Holy Spirit, I will – whether married or single – live a decent and chaste life, and avoid all that which incites unchastity.

L: "You shall not steal".

C: I will avoid everything that is stealing in God's sight: swindling, greed, and pointless squandering of His gifts.

L: "You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor".

C: I will guard and advance my neighbor's good name, and refrain from all gossip and slander.

L: "You shall not covet anything that belongs to your neighbor".

C: I will be content, whatever the circumstances, knowing that the Lord will never leave me nor forsake me. I will live always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
