Dear Friends,

In Ecclesiastes 3: 1 the preacher says that "for everything there is a season."

We are writing this at Dallas airport. We are waiting for our flight to San Franciso and from there on to Seoul, South Korea. We sense that we are about to enter another season of our lives together.

With all changes of seasons there is something that is left behind and something that is gained. We remember other leavings: leaving Denver for Grand Rapids, Grand Rapids for Managua, Managua for Dallas. We remember Joël leaving the law firm and us joining Christian Reformed World Missions. We remember the leavings that marked our passages from childhood to adulthood, from raising young children to becoming grandparents.


