People: Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight.

Leader: You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

People: Turn my heart toward your statutes and not toward selfish gain. Save me from all my transgressions.

Leader: The Lord is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth. He fulfills the desire of those who fear him; he hears their cry and saves them.

People: My mouth will speak in praise of the Lord. Let every creature praise his holy name for ever and ever.
