**Special Congregational Meeting:** The council has called for a special congregational meeting on Monday, June 17 at 6:30 pm to consider a proposal developed by the church facility team for relocating the church's parsonage from its present location to a location across the street south to property owned by the church surrounding the Cadet building. The proposal also includes a plan for updating the HVAC system of the home. If approved, the relocation would be planned for the summer and fall of 2024. A temporary housing option has been identified

for Pastor Darren and Emily and girls. The facilities team will present detailed information relating to the proposed relocation and answer questions at the congregational meeting prior to the formal vote. Because there will be discussion absentee ballots will not be accepted.
