



Thank you so much for your recent gift to Resonate Global Mission in support of our work in Zambia. We thank God for your partnership with us in mission. We have had a busy season of ministry since our home service last summer. Ryan returned in September as planned; Jody and the kids returned in November after attending her sister's wedding in Canada. In February our family moved to a new house in Lusaka. We are grateful for a more stable power supply (solar backup!) and more outdoor space.

Ryan taught two courses at Justo Mwale University in the final term of 2024 and the first term of 2025. He also spent two weeks teaching at the Anglican seminary in late March. The Shepherd's Academy, an online Bachelor of Theology program that Ryan coordinates, finished its first term in early May 2025. The second term is now underway. Ryan has also been involved with coordinating and leading several Timothy Leadership training events in Lusaka and Livingstone.

We appreciate your continued prayers for our family and our work. Evan (our oldest) finished his first year at Redeemer University in May and is living and working in Pella, Iowa for the summer. 
