Commissioning Litany

Serve 2025—Broken and Beautiful

Leader: Let us join together in reading the theme verse of the week: Isaiah 54:10.

Congregation: May the Lord, who loves you unfailingly, give you patience when you are tired, frustrated or overwhelmed. May you consider others before yourself and act out of kindness.

SERVE Participants: We receive his love and patience. We aim to demonstrate patience and kindness with others.

Congregation: May the Lord, who loves you unfailingly, give you courage as you meet new people, are invited to do new things and are pushed beyond your limits.

SERVE Participants: We receive his love and courage. We aim to follow where the Lord leads, even if it causes discomfort.

Congregation: May the Lord, who loves you unfailingly, give you compassion—for yourself, for your leaders, for your teammates and for those you serve.

SERVE Participants: We receive his love and compassion. We aim to show compassion to those around us.

of his love, strength, grace, hope, peace and compassion.
