Check ingredient labels carefully, as nuts can appear in unexpected foods such as baked goods, sauces, granola bars, or candies. Avoid Cross-Contamination: If preparing food at home for a church event, ensure all utensils, surfaces, and containers are cleaned thoroughly to avoid cross-contact with nuts.
