God has been good!

The last time we wrote we were just beginning our 2026 school year. How time flies!

In just another month and a half we will finish the first semester!

This has perhaps been our busiest time since we first came to Grace Global Christian School in September of 2023.

When Jeannie started the Little Lambs Kinder in March of 2024, she had four students. Three of the students were cousins.

The Little Lambs Kinder has grown each year and now has nine students! One of the original four students is now a second grader in our elementary school.

This year Jeannie faced another challenge. She needed to separate the nine students into a beginner class and an advanced class. That has meant separate lesson plans for each level.

In addition to this Jeannie has integrated subjects other than English into what she is teaching. Her goal has been to fully prepare her students for first grade. She spends long hours at home each evening and weekend preparing lesson plans and instructional materials.

I am so proud of what Jeannie has done with Little Lambs! From the beginning Jeannie introduced learning centers into her instructional method. Learning centers were new to her staff. It took time and hard work to train her staff. But she has succeeded!

I (Joel) have also been stretched the last few months. At the beginning of this semester, I agreed to be homeroom teacher for our new middle school class in partnership with a Korean teacher. I have also been teaching an English Language Arts class to our more advanced students and am co-teaching a class in Eastern Hemisphere history.

What I did not expect when I came to Korea were the opportunities to preach. I preach once or twice a month at an English language fellowship of a Korean church. It has been a rich experience. The fellowship in the past year has become almost 50% teachers from South Africa who are teaching English in Korea. The fellowship also includes a Filipino who is working at a factory in Changwon to support his family in the Philippines as well as Koreans who speak some English.

There is another opportunity I never expected. For the last year I have been doing a weekly program on a Christian radio station! The focus of the program is grace-based parenting. Two of the employees of the station now have children at Grace!

When Jeannie and I came to Korea in 2023 we had little idea of what we would be doing. There have been both “highs” and “lows.” We often feel inadequate to the task as foreigners who don’t know the language and are only beginning to learn the culture.

But God has been good! And you have been a big part of that with your prayers and support!

Praise and Prayer

Praise:

It was another beautiful spring in Changwon! Spring began with the cherry blossoms at the end of March. Little by little the brown of winter turned into the verdant green of spring!

Lord willing, we will be in Texas again this summer. We will leave Korea on July 10 and return on August 8.

Prayer:

Jeannie has struggled with some health problems since we returned in January. Please continue to pray for her health.

Our students will again go on a mission camp during the summer vacation. This year the mission camp will be in Japan. Please pray for the preparations for this camp. Pray that the camp will have a lasting impact on the lives of our students.

How can you help?

Most importantly, you can support us in prayer. This is a major move for us into a culture that is quite different from that of Nicaragua. Pray that we would be gracious learners of culture and language. Pray for our own discipleship as we learn from Korean Christians. Pray for the community of teachers, students, and parents of Grace International School as they live out a gospel of grace in a culture of achievement and performance.
