### **Psalm 23 - Family Visitation Questions**

1. When you hear the words, "The Lord is my Shepherd," what does that image of God mean to you personally?
2. In what ways have you experienced God's provision recently, "I shall not want"?
3. What are some "green pastures" or "quiet waters" God has used to refresh and encourage your family during this season of life?
4. Are there areas of your life where you need the Lord's guidance right now? How can we pray for wisdom and direction?
5. Psalm 23 says, "He restores my soul." What helps you stay spiritually refreshed and connected to Christ?
6. Have there been times when God has led you through a "dark valley?" How did you experience His presence during that time?
7. What fears or concerns are you currently facing, and how does the promise "You are with me" speak to those concerns?
8. The shepherd uses both a rod and a staff for protection and guidance. How have you experienced God's correction or guidance in your life recently?
9. Psalm 23 speaks of God's goodness and mercy following us all our days. Looking back, where do you see God's faithfulness in your family's story?
10. What does the promise of dwelling in the house of the Lord forever mean to you, and how does the hope of eternal life shape the way you live today?
